Report of the Committee on Classification of Congregations To the 238th Diocesan Convention March 5, 2022

St. John's Church in Camden no longer maintains regular church services. In accordance with New Jersey Revised Statutes, Section 16:12-16, the Committee moves that the Convention declare the parish corporation extinct.

The Right Reverend William H. Stokes has, in accordance with Diocesan Canon 60, Section 2(a), recommended the reclassification of the Parish Congregation of Grace Church, Plainfield, to Mission status, and the Diocesan Council has concurred with this recommendation. Accordingly, the Committee moves that the Convention ratify this change.

The Right Reverend William H. Stokes, in accordance with Diocesan Canon 60, Section 2(b), has accepted the request of the Parish Congregation of St. Martin-in-the-Fields, Lumberton, to be reclassified to Mission status, and, the Standing Committee having concurred with this request, the Bishop has so reclassified it. No action is necessary by this Convention for this change.

No other changes in classification have taken place since the last Diocesan Convention.
