\* The PPO 100 level plan is the base plan specified by the Diocesan Benefits Committee for 2023. Per diocesan canon congregations are required to pay 100% of the premium for any plan chosen by clergy and lay employees working at least 1500 hours per year.

\*\*Anthem BCBS or Cigna CDHP 20/HSA is a high deductible/health savings account plan. If any clergy or lay employee elects to participate in a high deductible health plan option, and the congregation elects to make a contribution to a health savings account of that clergy or lay employee, then parity applies, and the congregation must make an equivalent contribution to a health savings account for any other clergy or lay employee who participates in a high deductible plan.

\*\*\* Anthem BCBS BlueCard or Cigna MSP plans are Medicare Secondary Payer Small Employer Exception Plans. These plans allow Medicare Part A to be the primary payer for hospitalization for anyone who is over 65 and still employed.
