## SCHEDULING ORDER PURSUANT TO TITLE IV 13.5.c

On December 5, 2022, and following the submission of the parties' proposed discovery plan, the parties hereto participated in a scheduling conference with the Hearing Panel. As a result of the discussions during the conference, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- 1. On or before December 23, 2022
  - a. Each Complainant (the Right Rev. William Stokes, Julia Barringer and Mark Stewart) may propound document requests and no more than 20 interrogatories on Respondent; and
  - b. Respondent may propound document requests and no more than 20 interrogatories on each Complainant.
- 2. All Complainants and the Respondent shall respond to interrogatories and document requests, and produce documents not subject to an objection, on or before January 23, 2023.
- 3. The Complainants collectively and Respondent may take no more than two (2) depositions, which shall occur prior to March10, 2023; and

- 4. Any dispositive motions or pre-hearing challenges shall be submitted to the Panel no later than March 31, 2022.
- 5. A decision regarding the time and date or dates for a hearing is held in abeyance.
- 6. The Complainants may submit a memorandum to the Panel no later than motion no later than December 20, 2022 addressing Respondent's request for a copy of a Report prepared by Diane Sammons.
- 7. Respondent may respond to the Complainants' memorandum no later than January 6, 2023.
- 8. Complainants may submit a reply to Complainants' memorandum on or before January 13, 2023.
- 9. All parties shall make good faith efforts to limit their main submissions to three pages of substantive discussion (approximately 1200 words) and Complainant shall make a good faith effort to submit any reply submission to no more than one and a half pages of substantive discussion (approximately 600 words).
- 10. By copy of this Order, the Panel is advising the Chancellor of the Diocese of New Jersey regarding the request for a report that apparently belongs to it so that the Diocese may submit a statement of its position regarding this discovery issue.
